What is a Cookie?

Cookies are files containing small amounts of information that are downloaded to the user's device used when visiting a website. Their main purpose is to recognise the user each time they access www.piratesvillage.com and also allows us to improve the quality and usability of our website. Cookies are essential for the functioning of the Internet; they cannot damage the user's computer/device and, if they are activated in your browser settings, they help us to identify and resolve possible errors in the functioning of www.piratesvillage.com.

Types of Cookies

There are different types of cookies. They all work in the same way, but have small differences:

- Depending on the entity managing them:

- First-party cookies: these are cookies that are collected by the publisher itself in order to provide the service requested by the user.
- Third-party cookies: These are cookies that are collected and managed by a third party; they cannot be considered to be our own cookies.

- According to the length of time they remain active:

- Session cookies: these collect data while the user browses the web in order to provide the requested service.
- Persistent cookies: these are stored in the terminal and the information obtained will be used by the party responsible for the cookie in order to provide the requested service.

- According to their purpose:

- Technical cookies: these are necessary for the correct browsing of the website.

- Personalisation cookies: these allow the user to choose the characteristics (language) for browsing the website.
- Analysis cookies: these allow the provider to analyse the user's browsing habits in order to monitor the use of the website, as well as to compile statistics on the most visited content, number of visitors, etc.
- Advertising cookies: these allow the editor to include advertising spaces on the website, depending on the content of the website itself.
- Behavioural advertising cookies: these allow the editor to include advertising spaces on the website according to the information obtained through the user's browsing habits.
